Assembly Points

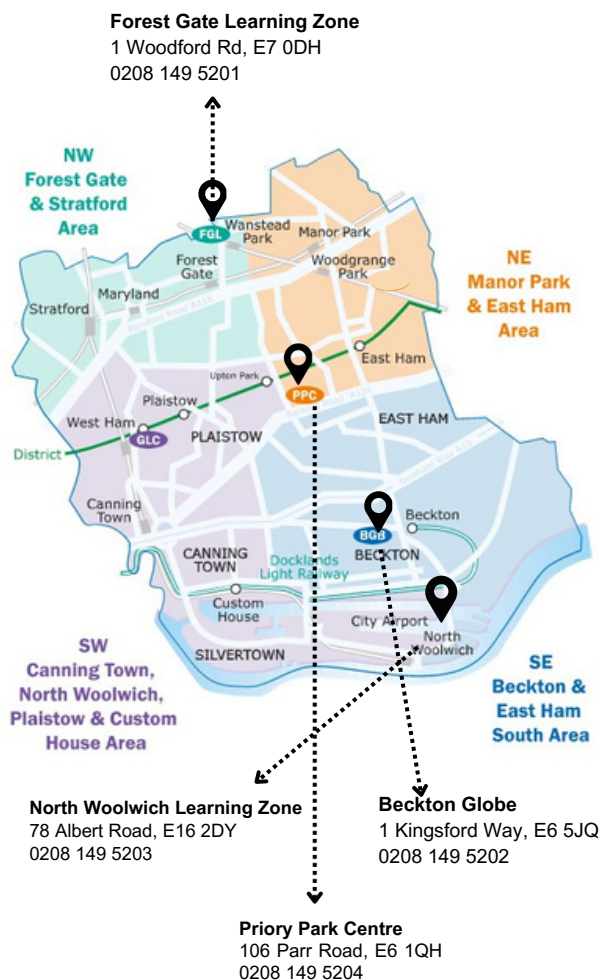
Forest Gate Learning Zone: Outside Youth Centre Entrance, Woodford Road. Outside Forest Gate Learning Zone Entrance Dames Road.

Beckton Globe: Front assembly point, middle of walkway between Kingsford School and Beckton Globe. Back assembly point, outside of Creche play area.

North Woolwich Learning Zone: Outside car park entrance.

Priory Park Centre: Outside Cleves Primary School entrance.
